Please can you send any donations you may wish to contribute with your child and these will then be collected, ready to send to the food bank.

The types of things you may send in are dried/tinned food eg:

- Cereal
- Pasta
- Noodles
- Rice
- Baked beans
- Peas
- Tinned fruit
- Tinned vegetables
- Sauce packet mix
- Sugar
- Tea bags
- Coffee.
